



Nemiah Valley Lodge - Location and Directions

We are located on Elkins Creek at the South end of Vedan Lake. Approximately 2.5 hours by road, southwest of Williams Lake.

- Travel west from Williams Lake on Highway 20 to Hanceville (approx. 90 kilometers).
- You will drop down a big hill and at the bottom you turn left onto Hanceville Canoe Creek Rd, It quickly turns to gravel.
- Travel down and cross the Chilko River and back up through Chilko Ranch (blue roofed barn).
- The road will fork so take the main, which travels to the right and will lead you through Stone (Yunesit'in) First Nation Reserve.
- Continue past that for about 75 km. It's a long gravel (well maintained) road. Along the way you may see some of the wild horses.
- You'll also see an old run down hunting camp at New Meadow, at about 43 km. The km markers get sparse, but at about 60 or so you will be on a long open part of the road. The mountain views are spectacular.
- You will continue and come up on a hairpin corner, Semore Draw and down the road will be a bridge that crosses the Taseko River. You will pass Big Lake on the right side.
- You will start to climb the Taseko Valley and drop right into the Elkin Valley. At the top of the hill will be our cattle guard and not long after that you will be able to look over the edge of the road and down to the right and see all of our cabins.
- Close to the bottom of the hill is our gateway to the right.
- Follow the driveway up to the main lodge and you will have finished the first leg of your adventure!
